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A BIT OF INFORMATION ABOUT THIS GUIDE...

This guide is organized by fibre type, then geographic region, for example, under the sheep category:

- *Vancouver Island*
- *Gulf Islands*
- *Fraser Valley*
- *BC Interior*
- *Washington State*
- *Washington State - Islands*

Those producers contact information but without pricing or product information are potential sources for fibre but information was unavailable either by phone, email or online as to whether they produced any animal fibre products (i.e. some sheep producers may farm for meat and not wool).

Therefore, this list is not exhaustive. There are many producers that I was unable to make contact with and many more that will remain anonymous – I imagine that they are out in the field without time to run a website or ensure they are listed in directories. The producers I spoke with were more than happy to provide detailed information about their animals and products, and as such friendly and knowledgeable people, they are your best resource for finding local fibres.

Please cross-reference the guide as many producers sell more than one fibre type (i.e. a sheep farmer may sell wool, but also alpaca fibres).

US producers list prices in US funds unless otherwise noted.

Canadian producers list prices in Canadian funds unless otherwise noted.

BATT

Washed and carded wool that is carded into a large, flat sheet. Used for blankets, quilting.

CARDING

Turning clean wools from staple to sliver form, and separating the fibres.

COMBING

Straightening long fibres and removing the shorter ones.

FLEECE

Washed wool which is uncarded. Fleece contains natural curls. Usually sold as a whole fleece (all fleece from one animal)

GRADING

Checking of each individual fleece, by eye and touch, and putting by hand into groups of the same type and quality, ready for sale at auction.

HANDSPUN

yarn spun by hand, either on a spindle or a spinning wheel

MICRON

Wool fibre diameter is quoted in microns. 1 micron = 0.001mm. The lower the microns figure, the finer the quality

MILLSPUN

yarn spun by machines at a mill

RAW WOOL

Wool from the sheep's back, still containing grease and dirt.

ROVING

Wool is carded into long, thick strands to be easily fed into a spinning wheel for spinning into yarn.

SKIRTED

When the stained wool is removed from the outer edges of the fleece once sheared

STAPLE (STAPLE LENGTH)

Length of fibre from shorn end to top of fibre

SPINNING

Pulling out the fibres and adding twist to make a continuous, strong thread.

TOPS

Long fibred wool which has been combed by machines.

YPP

Yards per pound

YARN

Washed, carded, and twisted/spun wool

ALPACA

domesticated camelid, bred only for fibre

CASHMERE

fibre from a Cashmere goat

COOPWORTH SHEEP

breed used for both meat and wool

COTSWOLD SHEEP

long-wooled breed dual-use breed providing both meat and wool

CRIA

baby llama

HUACAYA

breed of alpaca

ICELANDIC SHEEP

breed with dual-coated fleece in a range of colours

JACOB SHEEP

breed of primitive multihorned sheep, patterned with black and white spots.[1][2] Jacobs are grown for their wool, their meat, and their hides

LEICESTER SHEEP (ENGLISH LEICESTER SHEEP)

dual-use breed providing both meat and wool

LLAMA

South American camelid, used for packing, meat and fibre

LOPI

single-ply, loosely spun yarn, spun from the wool of Icelandic sheep, though other animal fibres can be used

PYGORA

cross between the Pygmy Goat and the Angora Goat that produces three distinct kinds of fleece

QUIVIAT

fibre from a Muskox

ROMNEY SHEEP

long -wooled breed

SHETLAND SHEEP

breed is noted for its fine, soft wool and the high quality of its meat

breed of alpaca

All of the animals on Bullock Lake Farm are kept for the fibre that they produce (llamas, Angora goats and six different breeds of sheep). After shearing, the fleeces are sorted and washed and then sent to the Gulf Islands Spinning Mill, for processing. The finished yarn is returned to the farm where it is dyed.

Our Lady of the Rock was instrumental in bringing white Cotswolds to the Pacific Northwest before 1990. This breed has gone from the endangered list to the “watch list” by the American Livestock Breed Conservancy. OLR now specializes in the Black (Colored) Cotswolds, which is basically an American breed. The fiber on these animals has a high silver to black sheen. Often three or four colors can be found in one fleece, which is ideal for hand spinners. They have had virtually no vet bills with this breed. They are a friendly, hardy, breed with long dreadlocks. They are very self-sustaining and need no special grains. The flock at OLR is out on forage nine months of the year.
